

May 2011 Monthly traffic update

9.2%

Total international passenger volumes increased 9.2% over May 2010. Australian traffic to Auckland increased 8.5% benefitting from additional capacity on Auckland-Cairns. Singapore traffic increased by 53.9% with Jetstar Asia adding approximately 19,700 seats to the market.

International passenger numbers through Queenstown has grown 53.2% this financial year to date on a 50.0% increase in aircraft movements. This increase has mainly been driven by Jetstar's expanded operations from December 2010.

Domestic passenger figures for May 2011 increased by 1.3% over May 2010. However the market did see a 2.2% capacity decrease compared to May 2010.
