Update on the redesign of Auckland Airport's international departure area

The hoardings are up and construction activity is well underway on the first floor of the international terminal. Over the next 18 months this area will take on a dramatic new look as it is structurally refitted and redesigned to improve the departure experience.

## So what's happening this month?

All the activity is happening in the landside departure area of the international terminal.

- You will notice some hoardings in the centre of the food court. The ceiling of this space is being modified to modernise it.
- In the next couple of weeks the seating area of the Jean Batten food court will be moved closer to Hayama Sushi to make way for some hoardings.
- Cafe Espresso, Sbarro, Taste of Asia and Sandwich Shuttle will remain in their location and be open for business as usual
- Oceanic Arts and the nearby toilet facilities are closing down.
- Whitcoulls is relocating to a new improved space next to Rip Curl.
- The NZ Post box will be found beside the new Whitcoulls store.
- Please use the alternative toilet facilities located next to McDonald's
